Proposed Constitutional Changes 2023/2024

1. Changing all Co-Chairs to Assistants

The proposed change was voted on and passed with zero opposition.

2. Add Toasts and Smokes Chair to Executive Board

The proposed change was voted on and passed with zero opposition.

3. Article IV Section 2 (pg. 17) - No member may propose or second more than three (3) candidates a year.

Proposed Change: Admission to Membership. No member may propose or second more than five (5) candidates a year.

The proposed change was voted on and passed with zero opposition.

4. Article IV Section 3 (pg.17) - All proposals must be submitted to the membership committee by the next regular monthly meeting.

Proposed Change: All proposals must be submitted to the membership committee by the date determined by the committee.

The proposed change was voted on and passed with zero opposition.

5. Article V - Provisional members shall pay \$60 chapter dues.

Proposed Change: Provisional members shall pay \$100 chapter dues.

The proposed change was voted on and passed with zero opposition.

6. Chapter Policies Section 2 - C (pg 26) They must still earn a minimum of fifty-six (56) hours, including fifty (50) percent of the required service hours, and twelve (12) continuing education hours.

Proposed Change: They must still earn a minimum of fifty-six (56) hours, including 24 of the required service hours and twelve (12) continuing education hours. - NAJA Rule
